

MINUTES OF THE HIGHWAY COMMISSION MEETING

October 4, 2023

The Williamson County Highway Commission met on Wednesday, October 4, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. at the Williamson County Highway Department facility at 302 Beasley Drive in Franklin, TN. Commission members present: County Mayor and Highway Commission Chairman Rogers Anderson, Stan Tyson, David Coleman and Charles Wilson. Commissioner Wayne Davis was absent.

Also present were: Eddie Hood, Highway Superintendent; Greg Boll, Highway Department; Joe Horne, Community Development Director; Floyd Heflin, William Andrews, Engineering; Phoebe Reilly, Budget Director; Robert Cook, County Attorney, Buerger, Moseley, and Carson, and other interested individuals.

Chairman Anderson called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m.

Special Announcements: There were no Special Announcements.

Elections and Appointments: There were no Elections and Appointments.

- 1. Request by Mr. Lange on behalf of Walk & Roll to Walnut Grove, for use of Williamson County roads described on the map of a parent school event to be held on October 4th, 2023. (HC Tyson; CC District 9, Morton/Williams).**

Superintendent Hood recommended approval. Robert Cook noted we have all legal items met and recommends approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Tyson for approval. It was seconded by Commissioner Coleman and passed unanimously, 4-0.

- 2. REPORT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF SOUTHERN PRESERVE LANE, SECTION ONE, AS A PART OF THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM. (HC Coleman; CC District 2, Hester/Herbert).**

Superintendent Hood recommended approval of report. William Andrews from community development recommended approval of report. A motion was made by Commissioner Coleman for approval of report. It was seconded by Commissioner Tyson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

- 3. REPORT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF SOUTHERN PRESERVE LANE, SECTION TWO, AS A PART OF THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM. (HC Coleman; CC District 2, Hester/Herbert).**

Superintendent Hood recommended approval. William Andrews from community development recommended approval of report. A motion was made by Commissioner Coleman for approval of report. It was seconded by Commissioner Wilson and passed unanimously, 4-0.

- 4. Resolution 10-23-9 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY MAYOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH THE STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTION FOR THE HILLSBORO ROAD PROJECT. (HC Tyson; CC District 9, Morton/Williams)**

Joe Horne recommended approval. Resolution is required due to increase in bid prices. Total project is projected to cost 3.7 million dollars. A motion was made by Commissioner Tyson for approval. It was seconded by Commissioner Coleman and passed unanimously, 4-0.

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5. Discussion Item: Sneed Road Bridge Project. (HC Tyson; CC District 9, Morton/Williams).

Superintendent Hood noted our bridges are inspected every two years by TDOT. He noted that after inspection this year the rating for the Sneed Road Bridge has dropped from fair to poor rating. He also noted the weight limit dropped from 40 tons to 34 tons. Traffic on bridge is approximately 10,000 vehicles a day. He made reference to state aid funds available of approximately 5 million dollars and another 1.4 million already designated for this bridge in the capital account. Chad Collier from Collier Engineering noted that the bridge will have to be moved to the south and built next to existing structure in order to keep existing bridge open during construction. Approach work would be completed by the highway department. He also noted the center pier would be removed for the new structure. . A motion was made by Commissioner Tyson to move forward with replacing the Sneed Road Bridge. It was seconded by Commissioner Coleman and passed unanimously, 4-0.

Commissioner Coleman: Commissioner Coleman had no road issues to report.

Commissioner Tyson: Commissioner Tyson had no road issues to report.

Commissioner Wilson: Commissioner Wilson had no road issues to report.

Commissioner Davis: Commissioner Davis was unable to attend.


Highway Superintendent Report: Superintendent Hood reported that Commissioner Wayne Davis fell while working on the bridge at his home and he was take to Vanderbilt for head trauma. He noted he spoke with him Monday and he had some broken ribs and hoped to rehab at Encompass by the hospital for a couple of weeks.

Highway Chairman Report: Chairman Anderson referred to Phoebe Reilly who reported Leslie Mitchell's father had suffered a stroke on Friday evening. She requested to please keep them in your prayers.

Legal Issues: County Attorney Cook had no legal issues to present.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at approximately 8:52 a.m.
