

WILLIAMSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

Thursday, September 24, 2020

MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met in person on Thursday, September 24, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. at the Williamson County Administrative Complex.

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Kim Henke, Member; Jonathan Duda, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; and Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections. Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

Mr. Duda made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 22, 2020, meeting. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 20, 2020, meeting. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to approve the August 27, 2020, minutes by amending the last paragraph to read "all households with a registered voter." Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

The minutes for September 8, 2020 and September 14, 2020, Election Commission meetings were deferred.

Mr. Duda made a motion to certify the results of the September 15, 2020, Town of Nolensville Special Election. Mrs. Smyth seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to accept Resolution 2020-115 for the City of Franklin for an Annexation Referendum for Certain Properties to be held in conjunction with the November 3, 2020, State & Federal General Election. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to set the Election Day Convenient Vote Center hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the November 3, 2020, State & Federal General. Mrs. Streiff seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.


Mr. Duda made a motion to substitute the Sunset Hills Baptist Church, located at 1635 Sunset Road, as an Early Voting location in lieu of the flooded Nolensville Recreation Center. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to substitute the Nolensville Town Hall in lieu of the Nolensville Recreation Center for Election Day, November 3, 2020. Mrs. Streiff seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

The Commission members agreed to postpone the appointment of the Early Voting & Election Day poll officials until the next meeting on Thursday, October 1, 2020.

The Commission members inspected 200 new voter registration forms and found no deficiencies.

The meeting was then adjourned.
