MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met electronically (virtually) in a called meeting under Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 16 which had been superseded by Executive Order 34 on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. at the Williamson County Administrative Complex.

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Kim Henke, Member; Jonathan Duda, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; and Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections. Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.
