Tuesday, July 14, 2020

MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. at the Williamson County Administrative Complex.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Kim Henke, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; Evelyn Watson, Deputy Administrator of Elections and Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections (via speakerphone). Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

Mrs. Smyth gave a report regarding the recent situation with poll worker Stephanie Wallace-Smith who is ready to move this with the understanding that policies would be put into place for the future. Thus the commission has tabled this. Mr. Brown stated that he asked Commissioner Jonathan Duda to investigate some of the policies and procedures in other counties regarding poll officials.

Mr. Gray informed the Commission that some action would need to be taken relatively soon regarding the potential special election in the Town of Nolensville should the voters in the August 6, 2020, Charter Referendum in the Town of Nolensville vote in favor of the adoption of a new charter.

Mrs. Streiff made a motion to certify the results of the Town of Thompson's Station Special Annexation Referendum. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

The Commission agreed to convene in a virtual meeting on Wednesday, July 22, 2020.
