MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met in a special called emergency meeting electronically (virtually) under Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 16 which had been superseded by Executive Order 34 on Monday, September 14, 2020, at 11:30 a.m. under the provisions pursuant to T.C.A. § 2-3-101 regarding the unexpected flooding of the Nolensville Recreation Center which was the only designated Election Day polling place for the September 15, 2020, Town of Nolensville Special Election.

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Kim Henke, Member; Jonathan Duda, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; and Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections.

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

Mr. Gray informed the Commission that the Town of Nolensville City Hall located at 7218 Nolensville Road had been secured as an alternative site for Election Day, September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Mrs. Streiff made a motion to relocate the Election Day polling location at the Nolensville Recreation Center to the Nolensville Town Hall. Mr. Duda seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.
