

WILLIAMSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

Tuesday, June 23, 2020

MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met on Tuesday, June 23, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. at the Williamson County Administrative Complex.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Kim Henke, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections; & poll officials Stephanie Wallace-Smith and Walter Banks. Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

Mrs. Wallace-Smith addressed the Commission regarding her grievances regarding her dismissal as a poll official. Mr. Brown agreed to appoint Commissioner Jonathan Duda and Commissioner Dana Smyth to explore the facts regarding the issue and investigate policies and procedures relating to poll officials. The Commission agreed to work with Mr. Gray on establishing some policies and procedures.

Mrs. Henke made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 20, 2020, meeting. Mrs. Streiff seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

Mrs. Henke made a motion to approve the minutes from June 4, 2020, meeting. Mrs. Streiff seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.


Mrs. Smyth made a motion to appoint the Early Voting and Election Day Poll Officials for the upcoming August 6, 2020, Federal & State Primary and County General Election allowing Mr. Gray to make continued appointments as needed. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

Mrs. Smyth made a motion to appoint the Election Day Poll Officials for the upcoming Town of Thompson's Station Special Annexation Referendum. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

Mr. Gray informed the Commission about absentee ballot processing and preparedness for the upcoming August 6, 2020, election. Approximately, 1,400 ballots had been processed at the time of the meeting with most absentee ballot operations occurring at the Historic Courthouse.

The Commission agreed to meet again on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. to convene and certify the Town of Thompson's Station Special Annexation Referendum election.

The meeting was then adjourned.
