

WILLIAMSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

Thursday, August 27, 2020

MINUTES

The Williamson County Election Commission met electronically (virtually) in a called meeting under Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 16 which had been superseded by Executive Order 34 on Wednesday, July 22, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. at the Williamson County Administrative Complex.

Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

A roll call of present members was taken and the following members were present: Robert D. Brown, Chairman; Dana Smyth, Secretary; Jonathan Duda, Member; Kim Henke, Member; Phyllis Streiff, Member; and Chad Gray, Administrator of Elections. Mr. Brown called the meeting to order.

The minutes from the July 22 & August 20th meetings were deferred.

Mr. Duda made a motion to approve the Early and Election Day poll officials for the upcoming September 15, 2020, Town of Nolensville Special Election. Mrs. Streiff seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Duda made a motion to certify the qualified municipal candidates in the City of Fairview and the Town of Thompson's Station appearing on the upcoming November 3, 2020, State & Federal General Election ballot. Mrs. Henke seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Gray gave an update on several new potential satellite early voting sites which would be in addition to our normal sites at the John P. Holt Brentwood Library, Nolensville Recreation Center, Longview Recreation Center, and Fairview Recreation Center. The Old Cedarmont Church on Arno Road, the Cool Springs Conference Center (Marriott), the Williamson County Agricultural Center, the Franklin Recreation Complex, and the Factory at Franklin were all discussed.

Mr. Duda reported that things were progressing well with the gathering of information concerning potential policies and procedures concerning poll officials.

The Commission agreed to convene again on Thursday, September 3, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. to approve the early voting locations for the upcoming November 3, 2020, election.

Mr. Gray updated the Commission that the Nolensville City Administrator asked that notifications be sent to all households with a registered voter.

The meeting was then adjourned.
