Monday, January 8, 2018	Wednesday, January 17, 2018 through Thursday, February 1, 2018	Shall Resolution No. 11-17-15, passed by the Williamson County Commission on November 13, 2017 published in the Tennessean, Williamson A.M., a newspaper of general circulation, and as authorized by and be levied and collected pursuant to the Retailer's Sales Tax Act and the 1963 Local Option Revenue Act under Title 67, chapter 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, which will increase the local option sales and use tax rate from 2.25% to 2.75% become operative?

*Voters in the City of Fairview are not entitled to vote on this measure.
City of Fairview voters approved a sales tax increase in a 2004 municipal
referendum and currently have the maximum amount of sales tax
allowed by law.
