INSTRUCTIONS

Pavers may be purchased to honor any Veteran whose death occurred while that individual was either in military service or after their service was completed. The Veteran does not have to be a former resident of Williamson County to receive a paver with the exception of the Group A pavers. Three lines of not more than eighteen (18) spaces may be used. Purchase price is \$65.00, and your order must be placed before February 15th if you wish to have the paver engraved and positioned prior to the next Memorial Day Service.

Please use the following information to determine what grouping the paver should be placed in:

DECEASED VETERAN

GROUP A: Williamson County Veteran who was in military service at the time of death, and was a war time casualty.

World War I: April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918.

World War II: December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946.

Korean War: June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955.

Vietnam: August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975.

Gulf War: August 2, 1990 – future date set by law or Presidential Proclamation.

GROUP B: Veteran who was in military service at the time of death, and was a war time casualty.

Vietnam: August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975.

Gulf War: August 2, 1990 – future date set by law or Presidential Proclamation.

GROUP C: Veteran who was on active duty at the time of death, but was not a war time casualty.

LIVING VETERAN

GROUP F: Living Veteran or sponsor who desires to pre-pay for a paver.

Pavers may be purchased in advance by a Veteran or his/her sponsor by requesting a Veterans Memorial Certificate. At the time of the Veteran's death, the certificate should be returned to the Williamson County Veterans Services Office for necessary action.
