Minimum qualifications required for this position are:

- Must be at least 18 years of age and a citizen of the United States.
- Must have a high school diploma or it's equivalent (G.E.D.)
- Must not have been convicted of, plead guilty to, or entered a plea of nolo contendere to a felony charge or to any violation of any federal or state laws or municipal ordinances related to force, violence, theft, dishonesty, gambling, liquor or controlled substances.
- Must not have been released or discharged under any other than honorable discharge from any of the armed forces of the United States.
- Must successfully complete and pass a drug screen.
- Must successfully complete and pass a psychological assessment.

Applicants must be able to work various days and shifts. The main function of the Deputy Sheriff (Detention) is to supervise inmates and their movements while in the Criminal Justice Center.

Starting pay is \$14.00 per hour (Plus shift differential)
Starting pay if Tennessee POST certified is \$16.50 per hour. (Plus shift differential) POST certification is not mandatory. Additional pay for Associate and Bachelor Degrees.
