WCSO Arrests Two Fleeing Suspects with Baby after Pursuit Ends

Two people are in custody after leading Williamson County Sheriff's Office deputies and Marshall County authorities on a pursuit that reached speeds as high as 90 miles per hour.

The pursuit started in Lewisburg, TN after Wallace M. Duncan, 39, and Tanova K. Ewing, 29, both of Lewisburg tried to flee from Marshall County authorities. Duncan was wanted on aggravated robbery and kidnapping charges in Sullivan County, TN.

WCSO deputies joined the pursuit around 12:30 this afternoon on I65 after a deputy spotted the BOLO vehicle. The pursuit ended about 30 minutes later at Arno Road and South Carothers after deputies, assisted by Franklin Police officers, deployed spike strips and the suspect's vehicle rolled to a stop in a ditch. No one was injured.

Deputies were surprised to find a baby secured in the SUV. Money and drugs were also found. DCS will try to identify the baby and locate his parents.

Duncan now faces additional charges in Williamson County. Ewing, who drove the fleeing vehicle, faces charges related to the pursuit. The Tennessee Highway Patrol is investigating the crash.
