2021 Annual Corrective Action Review

The Williamson County Sheriff's Office shall review data collected and aggregated pursuant to Prison Rape Elimination Act § 115.87 in order to assess and improve the effectiveness of its sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response policies, practices, and training, including by: (1) Identifying problem areas; (2) Taking corrective action on an ongoing basis; and (3) Preparing an annual report of its findings and corrective actions for each facility as well as the agency as a whole.

Review Board Members: Chris Gray – Detention Staff Sergeant, Chad Youker - Detention Lieutenant, Sean Luther - P.R.E.A. Coordinator, and Seth Obermeyer - P.R.E.A. Investigator.

Annual Review Findings: Upon the completion of the 2021 PREA Annual Review, the findings were as follows:

1. Added additional cameras to eliminate previously unknown blind spots around the facility.
2. The Sexual Assault Center has been placed on a free to call speed dial list for the inmates to utilize in the housing units.
3. Body cameras have been purchased and will be implemented at the beginning of 2022. This should make investigating verbal allegations much easier.
