INSTRUCTIONS

Pavers may be purchased to honor any Veteran whose death occurred while that individual was either in military service or after their service was completed. The Veteran does not have to be a former resident of Williamson County. Three lines of not more that eighteen (18) spaces may be used. Purchase price is \$65.00, and your order must be placed before February 15th so that there is sufficient time to engrave and position the paver prior to the next Memorial Day Service.

Anyone who purchases a paver will also receive a copy of the Williamson County Bicentennial publication *Portraits in Time*. Copies will be made available at the Veterans Services Office and the Williamson County Archives. Mailing cost is \$4.00.

DECEASED VETERAN

GROUP A: Veteran who was in military service at the time of death, and who was a war time casualty.

World War I: April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918.

World War II: December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946.

Korean War: June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955.

Vietnam: August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975.

Gulf War: August 2, 1990 to date.

GROUP D: Veteran who was retired from military service.

LIVING VETERAN

GROUP E: Living Veteran or sponsor who desires to pre-pay for a paver.

Pavers may be purchased in advance by a Veteran or his/her sponsor by requesting a Veterans Memorial Certificate. At the time of the Veteran's death, the certificate should be returned to the Williamson County Veterans Services Office for necessary action.
