1095-C Forms for 2021

The 1095-C form is provided to you as proof of the health coverage that Williamson County offered you and your dependents. It contains information about who provides the health insurance, as well as other information about the health coverage that was offered and if you elected coverage at any time during 2021.

Even though you may need to provide information regarding coverage when completing your tax return for 2021, you do not need your 1095-C form when you file the tax return. The IRS will receive a copy of the information provided to you on the 1095-C form.

Currently, there is no penalty for not having ACA mandated coverage in 2021 for residents of Tennessee. Consult your tax advice if you have questions regarding individual tax penalties.

1095-C forms are available to Williamson County employees eligible for benefits during 2021 by logging into the benefits system.

Your employee ID is the first four letters of your last name and the last four digits of your social security number.

Your Pin: is the last four digits of your social security number and the last two digits of your birth year.
