## About Environmental Reading Month:

- This free program is approximately **30-minutes-long**.
- Each class will receive a litter awareness pledge to sign and display in the classroom.
- Each student will receive a litter kit to take home, which will include an activity coloring book and a litter bag.

## *Second Grade – GLE 0207.7.3 (quarter 4)*

Environmental Reading Month content is correlated to the Tennessee State Standards and Williamson County Scope & Sequence for second grade. The program fits nicely into 4<sup>th</sup> quarter curriculum and is timely with Earth Day in April.
