

WILLIAMSON COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION RETIREE DISCOUNT INFORMATION

Williamson County Board of Education and Franklin Special School District Retirees (As of January 1, 2019)

Note: Any eligible participant must present their retired teachers card, issued by the State in order for the following to apply. The discount only applies to past employees, and they must apply and pay for any associated pass(es). Passes may be obtained from the Franklin Recreation Complex; the Indoor Sports Complex in Brentwood; the Longview Recreation Center at Spring Hill, the Fairview Recreation Complex or the Williamson County Recreation Complex at Nolensville.

All eligible retired teacher (s) qualify for a 20% discount on the cost of a standard or premium, single or family annual pass for use at all Williamson County Parks and Recreation facilities.

Standard Pass – basic rate that includes facility amenity use and access to seasonal outdoor pools and the Franklin Splash Park.

Premium Pass – all-inclusive rate that includes facility amenity use, access to seasonal outdoor pools and the Franklin Splash Park and admission to Group Fitness, Indoor Cycling, Senior Fitness and Aqua Fitness classes.

** Passes do not include admission to general recreation and/or art and crafts programs with an instructor.*

*** Annual Passes are good for one year from date of purchase.*

**** Annual Passes are accepted at all main Williamson County Parks and Recreation facilities, including the Franklin Recreation Complex, the Indoor Sports Complex in Brentwood, the Longview Recreation Center at Spring Hill, the Fairview Recreation Complex, the Williamson County Recreation Complex at Nolensville and the Williamson County Enrichment Center at Academy Park.*

*** No Refunds or Pro-Rates will be given on any previously purchased pass(es).*

*** Passes are Non-Transferable.*

+ Dependent children must be under 21 years of age and living at the same address as included on the pass application or be a full-time student, not over 26 years of age, and submit a valid full-time student identification card.
