The land disturbance activities must adhere to the following:

1. Agricultural land management activities, as defined by the Williamson County Storm Water Management Regulations, is the practice of cultivating the soil, producing crops, and raising livestock for the preparation and marketing of the resulting products.
2. Silviculture activities must be consistent with guidelines established by the State of Tennessee.
3. Acceptance of fill material, mining operations and/or borrow pits are not considered agricultural/silviculture uses.
4. If the land disturbance activity is being performed for something other than agricultural/silviculture use, Williamson County shall have the authority to issue Notices of Violation and citations, to impose the civil penalties, and to institute appropriate actions or proceedings at law or equity for the enforcement of the Storm Water Management Regulations. Any person violating the provisions of the Storm Water Management Regulations may be assessed a civil penalty by the County Engineer or Storm Water Quality Coordinator or his designee of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$5,000.00 per day for each day of violation.
5. The acceptance of this letter by Williamson County does not eliminate the potential to receive a Notice of Violation and/or an enforcement action issued by the State of Tennessee for land disturbance activities.

I understand and agree that the proposed land disturbance activities meet the applicable guidelines of agricultural/silviculture land management activities as outlined above.
