WILLIAMSON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT OFFERING BOOSTER DOSE OF PFIZER COVID-19 VACCINE

The Williamson County Health Department will offer booster doses of COVID vaccine to certain populations.

A single dose booster of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine can be administered for individuals who met these criteria:

- People 65 years and older and residents in long-term care settings should receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series,
- People aged 50–64 years with [underlying medical conditions](#) should receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series,
- People aged 18–49 years with [underlying medical conditions](#) may receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series, based on their individual benefits and risks, and
- People aged 18-64 years who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting may receive a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months after their Pfizer-BioNTech primary series, based on their individual benefits and risks.

The Williamson County Health Department will offer COVID-19 vaccines including the Pfizer-BioNTech booster dose from 1:00p – 3:00p Monday through Friday at the Williamson County Ag Expo Center, 4215 Long Lane in Franklin. Appointments are encouraged, but not required. To schedule an appointment, please visit <https://vaccinate.tn.gov>. Residents do not need to prove their diagnosis or health condition to be eligible for the booster dose.
