



Williamson County Election Commission is Conducting High School Voter Registration Drives During National Voter Registration Month & Promoting “Text My Gov” for Accurate Voting Information

The Williamson County Election Commission would like to remind everyone that Tuesday, September 17th is National Voter Registration Day. It is the high point of National Voter Registration Month, a time when state and county election officials work to encourage voter participation as well as increase awareness of voting requirements and deadlines.

“National Voter Registration Day is a great time to make sure that your registration is up to date or to register for the first time” said Williamson County Administrator of Elections, Chad Gray.

Each year in September the Election Commission conducts voter registration drives at public and private high schools in the county to register eligible students to vote.

This is the current schedule for this month:

Monday, September 16: Fairview High & Renaissance High
Tuesday, September 17: Page High & Nolensville High
Wednesday, September 18: Franklin High & Ravenwood High
Thursday, September 19: Independence High & Brentwood High
Friday, September 20: Centennial High
Monday, September 23: Summit High
Friday, September 27: Grace Christian Academy


