Eligible to participate:

- Full-time and part-time employees
- Spouses of full-time and part-time employees
- Dependent children of employees. Children under age 16 must be accompanied by a parent. All children under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian signature on their consent form.
- Retirees and covered spouses who are enrolled in the retiree medical plan.

Information About the On-Site Clinics:

- Wear appropriate attire to get to the deltoid muscle in the arm.
- The following flu vaccines will be available: Fluzone (for anyone over 36 months), Fluzone HD (anyone over 65 years old) and Flublok. For those with an egg allergy, Flucelvac will be available.
- If you are pregnant, you can get the flu vaccine.
- As part of the preventive health benefit under the Williamson County medical plan, covered employees can get their flu vaccine covered at 100%.
- Please bring your insurance card regardless of whether you are covered on the Cigna medical plan or another insurance provider.
- If an employee does not have insurance, Williamson County will cover the cost of the flu vaccine.
- Completion of [consent form](#) is required at time of vaccine.
