GENERAL ORDER REGARDING E-FILING


GENERAL SESSIONS

This cause came on sua sponte the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February, 2026. It appears that Williamson County General Sessions Civil Court documents should be filed electronically (e-filed) after February 16, 2026.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that:

1. All General Sessions Civil cases, will be efiled after February 16, 2026.
2. Pro se parties may e-file; however, pro se paper filings will be accepted and entered into the efiling system (eFlex) by the Clerk, and the paper filing will be returned to the filer.
3. The paper filer will be able to view the file in the General Sessions Civil Clerk's Office on the public access computer.
4. All registered e-filers will be able to view the electronic file on the eFlex system.
5. All files will be maintained electronically. After February 16, 2026, paper files will no longer be maintained by the General Sessions Civil Clerk's office.
6. Pursuant to statute, a paper copy of any part of an electronic file will be provided upon an open records request at a charge of fifty cents (.50) per page.
